Rehearsal Obligations:

Rehearsals tentatively begin on January 16th. Rehearsals will be held <u>either</u> in the afternoons or in the evenings, depending upon cast, production personnel, and space availability. There will also likely be Saturday morning or early afternoon rehearsals. There will be **NO** rehearsal on Sundays, or during the Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival (January 20-25), or on President's Day (February 17). It is possible that an actor may not be called for every rehearsal, but as we get closer to opening night, it is more likely that all actors will be called for all rehearsals. Technical rehearsals begin the week of February 18 and **every actor must be able to attend every technical/dress rehearsal and, of course, performance.** Crew and actors must make arrangements with classes, work, and other obligations to be at ALL rehearsals to which they are called unless a conflict has been communicated to and discussed with the director **IN ADVANCE**. No unexcused absence from a rehearsal will be acceptable and may result in removal from the production.

Roles are available for 4 - 18 performers, depending upon how many roles each actor is interested in and able to commit to. The Normandale Theatre Department holds diversity and inclusion as core values. Please indicate whether or not you will accept any role offered to you or if you are specifically interested in a particular role. A character list is available. Please indicate which genders you are open to authentically playing.

All NCC students who are cast in the show should consider enrolling in THTR 1120: Theatre Performance Practicum if they wish to receive credit for their work on the production.
